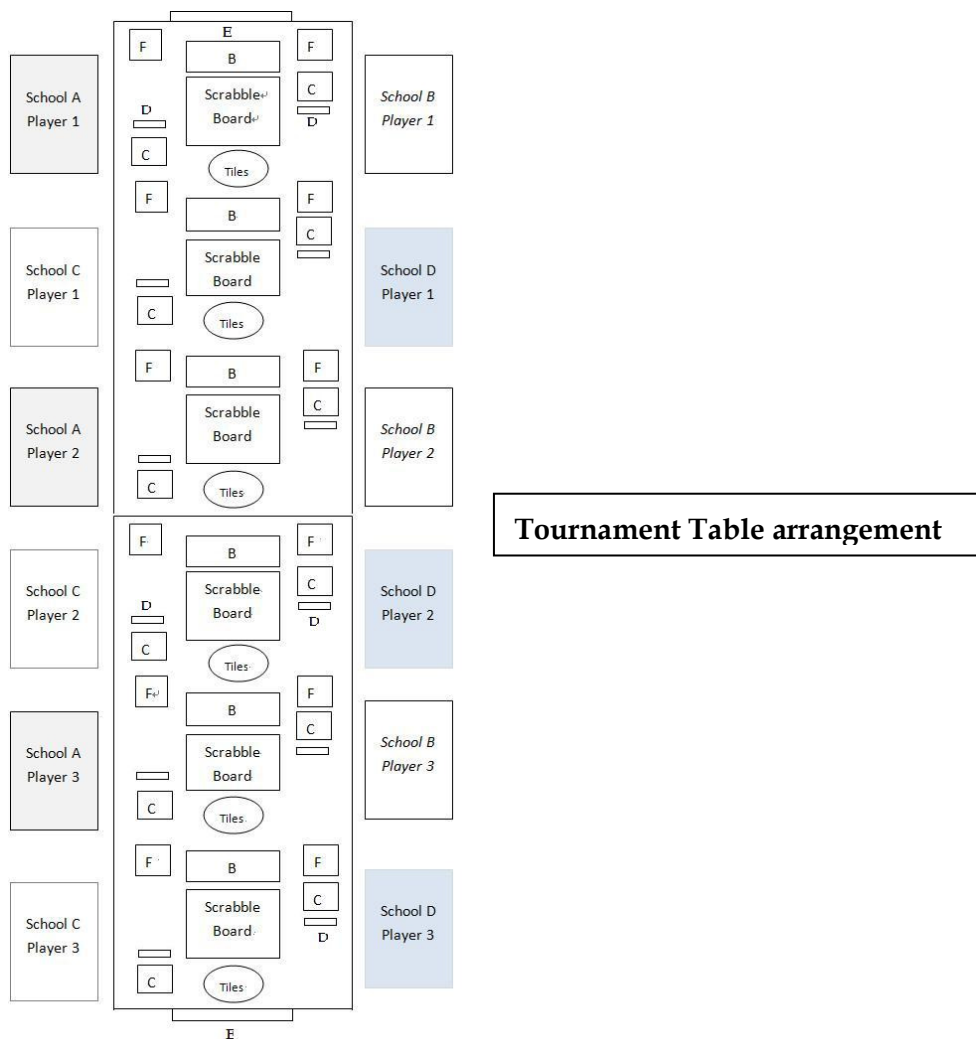

Important Notes

1. Students must wear their school uniform. If their schools do not require school uniforms, the students must put on their school badge.
2. Students must put on the Scrabble Pass and have to prepare their own lanyard and plastic holder for the pass.
3. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones or any other digital device during the game.
4. Eating or drinking is not allowed in the hall area or in the waiting room.
5. Students are not allowed to leave the venue area during the event except lunch hour.
6. Students should keep their valuables. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any valuable loss.
7. Students must observe the rules and instructions given by the Organizing Committee. Any student who disregards the rules will be disqualified from the Championship.
8. **Disclaimer:** the Organizing Committee is not liable for any personal injuries incurred or accidents occurring at the tournament.
9. **Storm Policy:** In case of typhoon signal No.8 or above, or black rainstorm warning, the tournament would be re-scheduled. The new re-scheduled date of Championship will be announced by email.

Tournament

2. Teachers, parents and the reserve players should wait in the waiting area during the game.
3. Students should register before each round of game. They should be back to the hall after the break.
4. Participating teams should decide the players at the beginning of a new game. Change of players is not allowed once the game has started.
5. On each tournament table, you will find the following for your game
 - A. An original Scrabble set
 - B. A Chess Clock for you and your opponent player
 - C. Challenge Slips
 - D. A pen
 - E. A label with the table number (at the edge of each tournament table)
 - F. A label showing your seat number



6. The total game time for each round is sixty (60) minutes. Participants may check against the Master Clock in the hall. Overtime is not allowed. When the time of Master Clock is up, players must stop even if the Chess Clock shows that there is still time left for individual players.
7. Any player who fails to turn up within fifteen (15) minutes after the game has started shall be deemed to have given up his/her game. For players who have turned up late but still within the first fifteen (15) minutes period, they can still start the game but they will only be able to play the game with whatsoever time that is left running on their timers.
8. Use of dictionaries, word lists, or calculator is not allowed throughout the game.
9. Each player shall be given a Scrabble Folder at the Registration Desk. In the folder, he/she will find some Score Sheets for recording the scores. He/she may ask for more during the game if the score sheets are not enough for the same round. For the Team Leader, he will find a Score Card for recording the total scores obtained by whole team. Each round needs one Score Card. Please refer to the Q&A to find out more about how to fill in a Score Sheet and the Score Card.
10. Players should verify and sign on the Score Sheets and Score Cards. The organizing committee is not responsible for any errors on the Score Sheet and Score Card.
11. The following cases are regarded as offending the tournament regulations:
 - Drawing tiles not over the eye-level
 - Exchanging tiles with a team member
 - Getting hints from a team member
 - Influencing the opponent
12. Players who have offended the tournament regulations will be given a penalty of mark deduction. Table Judges will give a yellow warning to players who have offended the regulations and will deduct the mark after two yellow warnings.
13. All matter in dispute shall be referred to the Organizing Committee whose decision is FINAL.
